





Executive Board Meeting of NADA

NADA executive board meeting was organized through video conferencing on 15th February 2021 under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Dept. of Sports. Matters pertaining to dope testing, panel constitution, draft Anti Doping Regulations including other urgent issues has been discussed in the meeting.

Re-accreditation training for the Sample Collection Personnel (SCP)

One day re-accreditation training cum education program for NADA empanelled sample collection personnel was conducted through virtual mode 18, 19, 24 and 25 February 2021 for different regions. Technical officials of NADA imparted training to the SCPs with regard to the new WADA guidelines of the sample collection procedure and common non-conformities observed. The training followed by assessment of SCPs through questionnaire which was based on sample collection procedure as per International Guidelines. SCPs qualified after assessments are empanelled by NADA for re-accreditation purpose.

Virtual consultation meeting of UNESCO with State Parties/ NCP

Regional consultations meeting of Bureau of 7th Session to the conference of parties to the International Convention against doping in sports was organized by UNESCO secretariat through video conferencing on 9th February 2021. Sh. Navin Agarwal, DG & CEO NADA attended the said consultation meeting on behalf of State Party. The meeting was attended by various representatives from other countries (State Parties) of Asia & Pacific Region.

The purpose of virtual consultation meeting was to discuss amongst the State Parties prior to the launch of the mandatory reporting cycle for 2020-2021 through the Convention's ADLogic system, The Official Notification inviting States Parties and territories to complete the online ADLogic questionnaire was circulated on 10 February alongside the revised edition of the *Compliance Guidelines*, with the deadline to complete the questionnaire by 26 March 2021.
